Calistoga Food & Wine Festival at Solage

Executive Chef Brandon Sharp of Michelin star **Solbar** welcomes chefs Reylon Agustin of Traci Des Jardins' **The Commissary** and Bradley Borchardt of **Expanding Palates** at the 2nd annual **Calistoga Food & Wine Fest** (\$95/per personp) on Friday, April 24 from 6pm-9pm. Stroll the lush lawns of Solage while exploring the wines of 30 Calistoga wineries, sampling delicious passed canapes and small plates prepared a la minute at live cooking stations. Bluegrass music by Ed & Friends sets the down-home, yet very hip, vibe of the new Calistoga.

Stag's Leap District Vineyards To Vintners Weekend

19 **Stag's Leap District** vintners offer exclusive access to their homes and wineries during the **V2V Open Houses** on Saturday, April 25 from 10am-4pm. Vintners will offer special activities plus food and wine pairings featuring limited release wines and barrel samples. On Sunday, April 26 from 10:30am-1pm, preview the 2012 vintage collection during a vintner-hosted brunch on the patio at Silverado Vineyards with food catered by Meadowood Resort. Here are just some of the reasons to visit the vintner Open Houses:

-Meet icons and legends: Stag's Leap quality pioneers such as John Shafer will be on hand to welcome visitors. At Shafer Vineyards, guests will

have the special opportunity to taste the 2006 Hillside Select, so limited in quantities it won't be available for sale.

- -See the Future of Stag's Leap: The latest member of the district, **Odette Estate**, will give tours of its green winery, designed to LEED Gold standards by **Signum Architecture**, featuring a living roof and repurposed shipping containers as well as educate visitors about its organic farming practices.
- -Exclusive access: Visit wineries not normally open to the public like **Lindstrom Wines** or head to **Stag's Leap Wine Cellars**, whose "BBQ and Blues" event takes place on the patio of Nathan Fay's former residence in a secluded spot on the property. It was Fay who first planted Cabernet in Stag's Leap and inspired vintners like Shafer and Warren Winiarski to invest in the District.
- -Great food, wine and music abound on this day, starting with the very popular "Bienvenue Brunch" in the Olive Grove of **Clos du Val** where they'll be serving chilled Sauvignon Blanc with savory crepes until noon, switching over to Cab and more pairings with the sounds of various French jazz artists wafting in the background.

Tickets are \$175/per person for Saturday's Open House pass or \$300/per person for a 2-day pass including the vintner-hosted brunch and 2012 vintage preview. For more information, locations and to book, visit the **website**.
